Jointly organised by the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Engineering and the Office of Life Sciences, we seek outstanding candidates who have keen interest in pursuing further graduate studies in biomedical sciences.

NUS Chemical Sciences - A*STAR Pre-Graduate Award

Students in this programme may apply for the A*STAR Pre-Graduate Award at the end of Year 1. The Pre-Graduate Award (PGA) will commence in Year 2 of the programme for a period of three years. Successful applicants will have their tuition fees waived for the duration of receipt of this award, in addition to a monthly allowance. Terms and conditions apply.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicants who meet the following requirements are welcome to apply to the Chemical Sciences Programme:

- Must enrol in Faculty of Science, reading Chemistry major or Faculty of Engineering, reading Chemical & Biomolecular Engineering major
- Outstanding academic records and a strong commitment to pursue graduate studies and a research career
- Good 'A' Levels Chemistry and Biology
- Singapore Citizens, Permanent Residents or Nationals of ASEAN countries*

Shortlisted candidates may be required to undergo interviews to be held in NUS.
